**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL WEEKLY CCFC MEETING HELD ON
30.07.2026 at 15.30 Hrs.**

Based on the Board's instructions, a special weekly CCFC Meeting to review Import-Export related issues in view of the prevailing global situation (Gulf Crisis) and SCMTR weekly outreach programme to sensitize all stake holders about the provisions of the smooth implementation of SCMTR, 2018 was conducted on 30.07.2026 at 15:30 hrs. at the Conference Hall, Tiruchirappalli Customs (Preventive) Zone, Trichy in hybrid mode for the convenience of the trade, under the Chairmanship of P.V.N Suresh Babu, Chief Commissioner of Customs, Tiruchirappalli (Preventive) zone.

2. The CCFC meeting was attended by the representatives of the Officer of the Chief Commissioner of Customs, Tiruchirappalli (Preventive) Zone, Officers of Trichy Customs (Preventive) Commissionerate and Tuticorin Customs House Commissionerate and other members/stake holders falling under the Jurisdiction of the Zone. The details of the same are attached vide Annexure-A.

3. Shri. Shree Hari Shankar P, Additional Commissioner, CCO, Tiruchirappalli welcomed all the attendees. The following points put forth by the trade were taken up for discussion.

(i) Point raised by Shri. Karthikeyan M, TEA Logistics Committee, Tirupur

Shri. Karthikeyan M, Tirupur Exporters Association, logistics Committee, Tirupur, stated that traders are facing critical supply chain disruption stemming from persistent transshipment bottlenecks in Colombo and acute regional feeder/equipment shortages at V.O Chidambaranar Port (Tuticorin) and these cascading issues threaten export fulfilments, contractual delivery deadlines and overall competitiveness. He further stated in this regard they are representing to Ministry of Ports, shipping and Waterways for

deployment of Emergency Feeder Capacity and Priority Berthing and sought from the Chairperson for the Department's guidance and support in the interest of trade facilitation and export competitiveness of the region.

Reply:-The Chairperson acknowledged the problems faced by the traders and replied that necessary support on the part of the Department will be extended in this regard and if any specific redressal by the members of the Association, they may address to the Pr. Commissioner, Custom House, Tuticorin Commissionerate.

5. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair and all participants.
