

The interested parties/Individuals are to submit their bids in the prescribed format as annexed to this notice (Annexure-B) along with Earnest Money as Demand Draft of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) for each vehicle in favour of “The Assistant Commissioner of Customs, Customs Division, Tuticorin”. Any enquiry / details regarding the tender and terms and conditions can be obtained from the Superintendent, Divisional Preventive, O/o Assistant Commissioner of Customs, Customs Division, No.66, Beach Road, Tuticorin, on any working day during office hours on or before 11/12/2017. **Last date for submission of tender is 11/12/2017 up to 17:00 Hrs.** Late submission of tenders shall not be accepted. The competent authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the quotations without assigning any reason.



ANNEXURE-A

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The sealed bid shall be **received by this office up to 05:00 PM on 11th December 2017**. Any bid received after the prescribed deadline shall not be considered. Tender should be addressed to "The Assistant Commissioner of Customs, Customs Division, No.66, Beach Road, Tuticorin".
2. The bids shall remain valid for a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the bid.
3. The rates quoted by the bidders for purchase of old condemned vehicles will be all inclusive and on "As is where is basis". Any statutory or other charges/Taxes shall be borne by the bidder. The successful bidder will take possession of the vehicles on a date and time specified by this office and will arrange for transportation of the same on that day at his expense.
4. The vehicles will be disposed off on the basis of highest rate. However, this office reserves the right to withdraw the vehicles from the bidding process in case the quoted price received is less than the reasonable market price.
5. The successful bidder must adhere to the time limit. Failure to deposit the requisite sum before the stipulated date/time entails the forfeiture of the contract as well as Earnest Money deposited. After delivery of the vehicles, this office will not be responsible for any damages to the vehicle or person
6. This office reserves the right to annul the bidding process at any time prior to award of contract including rejection of any or all bids after the same have been received, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder/s or any obligation to inform the affected bidders on the ground of this office's action
7. The bidders may physically visit and inspect the vehicles before putting in their bid. The Superintendent, Preventive Unit, Custom Division Tuticorin may be contacted for inspection of the vehicles. **The inspection of the vehicles may be done from 10:00 AM to 05:00 PM of any working day up to 11/12/2017**. No complaint whatsoever will be entertained after closing of tender. No request for inspection after submission of tender will be accepted.
8. The vehicle shall be handed over to the successful bidder against 100% deposit of offer/bid value.
9. The payment will be accepted by this office in the form of **Demand Draft of a nationalized bank** only. The payment has to be submitted by the successful bidder within 7 days of the date of delivery of the order otherwise the offer will be cancelled and earnest money shall be forfeited.
10. Disputes, if any, shall be subject to jurisdiction in the Court of Tuticorin only.

11. Tendering form should be signed in ink by the authorized signatory only. Photocopy or unsigned quotations or quotations not signed by authorized signatory shall be rejected.
12. Once the release order issued, this office will not be responsible either for safe custody or for any loss or damage to the subject vehicle.
13. In case the bidder is a company, the name of the company should be indicated as the bidder. In such cases the person appearing for the company should have the authorization letter in a proper format issued from a competent authority of the company. Request to change the name of the bidder in the tender after submission of the tender will not be entertained.
14. The sealed tenders super scribed "**Tender for sale of condemned office vehicle**" will be opened on **13/12/2017 at 11:00 A.M** in presence of bidders, if any.
15. The scheduled day for opening the sealed tenders, if declared to be holiday due to any unforeseen reasons, the same will be opened the next immediate working day.
16. The bidders should quote the amount for purchase of the subject vehicle both in words and in figures, if there is any difference between the amounts mentioned in figures and that of in words, the rate quoted in words will be taken in to account and accepted on record.
17. The bidder is required to reveal his full name/name of the authorized signatory of the firm/name of father, full postal address, telephone number & mobile number
18. The person authorized by bidder will be allowed to take the delivery. The bidder is required to produce any of documents as documentary evidence for proof of their address.(Ration Card /Voters Identity Card in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms etc.)
19. The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the vehicle transferred in his name at his own cost expeditiously. This office will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard.
20. The vehicle will be delivered only after the receipt of full payment and has to be lifted at their own expenses within 07 days of completion of deal. Permission to take out the disposed vehicle from the O/o Assistant Commissioner of Customs, Customs Division, Tuticorin will not be allowed on holidays, Saturdays and Sundays etc.

Sealed Tenders are invited by the Assistant Commissioner of Customs, Customs Division, Tuticorin on behalf of the Commissioner of Customs, Trichy from interested parties for the Auction of the goods listed in the Annexure to this Notice to be held at **1200 hours on 13.12.2017** subject to the following conditions:


02. Separate sealed Tenders on plain paper should be submitted quoting the price indicating the serial number of the goods mentioned in the Annexure for each item. The Tender price should be exclusive of GST and all other applicable Taxes and cess, wherever applicable.
03. The Earnest Money Deposit [EMD] of **Rs 1,000/-** [One Thousand Only] in the form of Cash may be deposited at the time of submitting the Sealed Tender. The EMD amount received from unsuccessful Tenderers will be refunded to them on 13.12.2017 itself.
04. Sealed Tenders will be received at the Office of the Assistant Commissioner of Customs, Customs Division, Tuticorin **up to 1700 Hrs. on 12.12.2017** and will be opened in the presence of the Tenderers at **1200 Hrs. on 13.12.2017** itself. If there are Corrections/over-writings/additions or deletions in the Tender the same are liable for rejection.
05. If the Tender price is not acceptable, Open Auction among the Tenderers only will be conducted on the same day.
06. The goods may be inspected by the prospective Tenderers at the Office/places mentioned at Column 5 of the Annexure to this Notice during normal Office hours on all working days upto **1700 Hrs. on 12.12.2017**.
07. Only the highest bid will be accepted and the successful Tenderers/Bidders shall be required to pay 25% of the Tender value/Bid amount by Cash on the spot on acceptance, including provisional acceptance. The remaining amount with appropriate GST and Surcharge thereon, if any, has to be paid within seven days of the date auction/intimation of final acceptance, in case of provisional acceptance failing which the 25% advance amount already collected will be forfeited to Government without any notice. Apart from the sale value, applicable GST and cess thereon, if any, that may be levied shall be payable by the successful Tenderers/Bidders.
08. The goods shall remain in the custody of the Department in every respect at the risk of the Bidder from the date of acceptance, including provisional acceptance of the bid and the Government shall not be under any obligation for safe custody or the preservation there from the date of acceptance including provisional acceptance.
09. When the purchaser is not given delivery of the goods for any unforeseen reasons after acceptance of bid, he shall not be entitled to make any claim for damage, loss/profit or compensation on any account.

10 Whenever any claim for the payment of sum of money to the Government arises out of or under auction sale against the buyer, the Government shall without prejudice to any other remedy, be entitled to deduct such sum of money at any time thereafter from any sum that may become due to the buyer under any contract with the Government and this is not sufficient to cover the full amount recoverable. The buyers shall pay to the Government on demand the balance remaining due.

11. All disputes arising out of or in any way touching or concerning the agreement for sales whatsoever shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the Commissioner of Customs, No. 1, Williams Road, Cantonment, Trichy or any person nominated by him. It shall not be objected that the arbitrator is a Government servant that he had to deal with all or any other matter in dispute. The decision of such arbitrator shall be final and binding on parties to the agreement.

12. The department reserves the right to reject any or on all Tenders/Bids without assigning reasons thereof. The Department also reserves the right to withdraw any or all goods from the Tender/Auction without assigning any reasons. The decision of the Assistant Commissioner will be final in this regard.

13. Sale of goods is purely on 'AS IS WHERE IS' condition basis. The goods shall be taken from the site with all faults or errors in description or otherwise, quantities, size, measurement, number, weight as stated in the lots. No warranty or guarantee shall be implied. The above goods are sold on the assumption that the bidders have inspected the lots and know what they are buying. The principle of 'caveat emptor' will apply and no complaint will be entertained after the sale.
