Subject: Ease of Customs Duty Payment - Introduction of Payment Aggregator - reg.

Attention of all Importers, Exporters, Customs Brokers, Trade Associations, and the General Public is invited to Circular No. 13/2026-Customs dated 24.03.2026 issued by the Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs regarding introduction of **Payment Aggregator** as an authorised mode for payment of Customs duty through ICEGATE.

2. In continuation of the ongoing initiatives for trade facilitation and simplification of Customs duty payment, ICEGATE e-Payment platform has enabled **Payment Aggregator** with the following features:

- a. Payment of Customs duty using Credit Card, Debit Card and UPI (introduced for the first time).
- b. Internet banking through Payment Aggregator is covering multiple banks.
- c. Complementary facility to existing modes such as authorised banks Internet banking and NEFT/RTGS.

- d. Transaction-wise payment routed through Electronic Cash Ledger (ECL) instantly.
3. It is further informed that any commission/charges, if applicable, levied by banks/payment aggregator for transactions made through this mode shall be borne by the person making the deposit.
4. At present, the Payment Aggregator facility has been enabled with select banks and more banks will be on boarded in due course. A detailed **User Manual** is available on the ICEGATE website for guidance of stakeholders.
5. Trade and all stakeholders are requested to make use of the above facility for ease of Customs duty payment. Officers under the jurisdiction have been advised to sensitize and assist stakeholders in adopting the new payment mechanism.
6. Difficulties, if any, faced in implementation of the above may be brought to the notice of this office.
