Despite ICD Hosur's strategic importance to a major industrial belt and gateway ports, the custodian is perceived to be neglecting core custodial duties and instead engaging in end-to-end logistics activities, adversely impacting Customs Brokers, Freight Forwarders, and Shipping Lines. This has led to cargo diversion away from ICD Hosur and declining stakeholder confidence. It is requested that the Chief Commissioner closely monitor the custodian's functioning, ensure adherence to defined responsibilities, and initiate corrective action if improvements are not observed, while maintaining confidentiality.
