The Chairman welcomed the members of the trade and the officers present. **The minutes of the previous PTFC meeting held on 05.03.2026** was discussed as detailed below:

Further, the following agenda points/issues were discussed in detail and the point-wise Minutes of the Meeting are as below:

Point 1: Rectification of RoDTEP Credits and Issuance of Differential/Scrolls filed during 23 February, 2026 to 22 March, 2026:-

The representative informed that differential RoDTEP benefits in respect of Shipping Bills filed during the period from 23.02.2026 to 22.03.2026 are yet to be credited consequent upon revision of RoDTEP rates under DGFT Notification No. 66/2025-26 dated 23.03.2026, which superseded DGFT Notification No. 60/2025-26 dated 23.02.2026. The trade requested issuance of differential scrolls and credit of the eligible differential RoDTEP benefits in respect of the affected Shipping Bills.

Despite the issuance of the superseding notification 66/2025-26, the following system level gap were identified in their ICEGATE RoDTEP ledger-

- i. RoDTEP scrolls for shipping bills filed during the period 23 February, 2026 to 22 March, 2026 have been processed and credits generated at the 50% restricted rate under notification 60/2025-26 dated 23.02.2026 at the time of scroll generation.
- ii. No automatic recomputation, differential credit or supplementary scroll has been issued in the ICEGATE ledger subsequent to the suppression by notification .

66/2025-26 dated 23.03.2026.

- iii. The credits currently reflected in their RoDTEP for the said period represent a shortfall of 50% of their legitimate entitlement under the restored notification.
- iv. This constitutes a direct mismatch between the operative DGFT policy position and the customs/ICEGATE system implementation, to the financial detriment of the exporter.

Reply: The Chairperson acknowledged the issue raised and asked to share the detailed write up of the issue being faced by the trade body and assured that the matter would be pursued with the concerned authorities to facilitate an early resolution.

Point 2: Resolution of Pending SB006 Cases (IGST Refund Blocked):-

The representative highlighted that several export Shipping Bills are pending under SB006 status, resulting in non-processing of IGST refunds despite completion of export formalities. It was submitted that the issue is primarily attributable to EGM-related discrepancies such as non-mapping of EGM with Shipping Bills, non-transmission of EGM data, gateway EGM mismatches, and non-availability of EGM records in the system. The trade informed that supplementary EGMs have been filed and representations have been submitted to the concerned authorities; however, the issue remains unresolved. The trade requested verification and rectification of EGM-related discrepancies, clearance of SB006 errors, and expeditious processing of pending IGST refunds.

Reply: The Chairperson acknowledged the issue raised and requested the stakeholder to furnish a detailed write-up along with the relevant documents for examination. The Chairperson further assured that the matter would be taken up with the concerned authorities for expeditious resolution.

Point 3: Request Ex-Bond BoE Filing facility in ICEGATE System for Imports from FTWZ/SEZs:-

Recently the WH BoE filing facility was introduced in ICEGATE Systems, for imports from FTWZ/SEZ Units to Moowr Units. 2) If the Moowr unit consumes such bonded goods for domestic market sales, then the applicable duties, contained in those domestic sales volume, to be paid by filing an Ex-Bond BoE. 3) Currently the ICEGATE System doesn't have facility to file an Ex-Bond BoE and for paying the applicable duty, in FTWZ/SEZ to MOOWR Module.

Point 4: Request for a System facility to add/edit IGCR Bond number and debit IGCR duty value, during filing of WH or Ex-Bond BoE, for domestic consumption. (FTWZ/SEZ to MOOWR):-

The trade represented that the present ICEGATE module allows entry of only one bond number while filing WH BoE for FTWZ/SEZ to MOOWR transactions. As a result, importers are unable to capture IGCR Bond details and avail concessional duty benefits under the IGCR framework. The trade requested provision of appropriate fields in the system to enable declaration and debiting of IGCR Bond details while filing WH/Ex-Bond Bills of Entry.

Point 5: Reflection of WH Bills of Entry in IDPMS:-

It was represented that WH Bills of Entry filed through ICEGATE for FTWZ/SEZ to MOOWR transactions are not getting reflected in the IDPMS system, resulting in difficulties in effecting payments to the suppliers. The trade requested that necessary system integration be provided to ensure reflection of such Bills of Entry in IDPMS and facilitate timely remittances.
