Subject: Facilitation for filing of E-manifests under SCMTR Regulations, 2018-Reg.

Attention of all the Authorized Sea Carriers (ASC), Authorized Sea Agents (ASA), Authorized Transhipper (ATP), other entities/stakeholders, and members of the Trade in the jurisdiction of Tuticorin Custom House Commissionerate is invited to the Sea Cargo Manifest Transhipment Regulations, 2018 (SCMTR, 2018).

2. In this connection, it has been observed that despite numerous efforts for handholding the concerned entities and address the difficulties faced by them, the filing of e-manifests: SAM (Sea Arrival Manifest), SEI (Sea Entry Inward), CSN (Cargo Summary Notification), SDM (Sea Departure Manifest), SDN (Sea Departure Notification), CIM-AR (Customs Inland Manifest Arrival), CIM- DP (Customs Inland Manifest- Departure) under SCMTR 2018 is significantly low due to repetitive errors resulting in faulty filings. It is to be noted that CBIC has commenced final preparatory phase for migration into the new system from 31st August 2024 onwards.

3. In order to further facilitate and ensure error-free filing of e-manifests, all the ASC/ ASA/ Transhipper registered /operating under the jurisdiction of Tuticorin Custom House are hereby allocated to the **Deputy/Assistant Commissioner of Customs in charge of IG section of Custom House, Tuticorin.**

4. In this regard, all the allocated ASC/ASA/Transhipper are advised to acquaint themselves with the common repetitive errors received while filing the e-manifests and intimate the concerned Deputy/Assistant Commissioner of Customs about the success/failure of such filings and difficulties faced, if any, before the arrival of the vessel. Also, they may approach the concerned officer, in case of any genuine difficulty faced with errors

related to the system, if any, for further escalation with DG Systems.

5. The Deputy/Assistant Commissioner of Customs will ensure that all the allotted ASC/ASA/Transhipper under them are filing e-manifests. They should escalate the system-related errors that are not resolved locally in filing e-manifests to the Deputy Director, DG Systems under intimation to the Joint Commissioner, EDI.

6. Any difficulty faced in the implementation of this Public Notice may be brought to the notice of this office. This facility notice shall also be treated as a Standing Order for the purpose of officers and staff.
